

Domashevsky S.V. The new data on rare species of the birds of prey in the Kiev Region (Ukraine). // Strepet. – 2004. – Vol. 2.- № 2. –P. 5-27.

The data collected in 1988-2004 in the North of Ukraine in the Kiev Region are submitted. The area is divided from the north into the south by natural zones – Polesye and Forest-steppe. The material on migrations, distribution, ecology, number and registration of 10 species of the birds of prey brought in the Red data book of Ukraine (*Osprey Pandionhaliaetus*, *Hen Harrier Circuscyaneus*, *Pallid Harrier Circusmacrourus*, *Long-Legged Buzzard Buteorufinus*, *Short-Toed Eagle Circaetusgallicus*, *Booted Eagle Hieraaetuspennatus*, *Spotted Eagle Aquilaclanga*, *Lesser Spotted Eagle Aquilapomarina*, *Imperial Eagle Aquilaheliaca*, *Golden Eagle Aquilachrysaetos*, *White-tailed Eagle Haliaeetusalbicilla*, *Griffon Vulture Gypsfulvus*, *Gyrfalcon Falcorusticulus*, *Saker Falcocherrug*, *Peregrine Falcoperegrinus*) is collected. The nested population of some species of birds of prey is appreciated in such number: *Buteorufinus*– 11-14 pairs, *Circaetusgallicus*– 44-52 pairs, *Hieraaetuspennatus*– 10 pairs, *Aquilapomarina*– 90-100 pairs, *Aquilaheliaca*– 2-3 pairs, *Haliaeetusalbicilla*– 14-19 pairs, *Falcocherrug*– 5-8 pairs, *Falcoperegrinus*– 1-2 pairs.
