# Accommodation

There is a range of accommodation options in Wallingford and the surrounding area, we have provided some details and travel options below. Let us know if we can help any further.

#### Suggested accommodation

We have agreed a discounted rate with the <u>Shillingford Bridge Hotel</u> (just outside Wallingford) of £85 per room per night bed and breakfast. Other accommodation options are listed below. Note that unfortunately we can only provide transport to and from the Shillingford Bridge Hotel.

# Wallingford

Stay in Wallingford itself with a short walk over the Thames to CEH.

- Airbnb there are several (~10) Airbnb rooms in Wallingford with prices from £40
- The Partridge small inn in the centre of Wallingford (15 minute walk from CEH) with prices from £50
- <u>Little Gables</u> small B&B located in Crowmarsh Gifford (10 minute walk from CEH) with prices from £90 including breakfast
- <u>Coachmakers Arms</u> small inn in the centre of Wallingford (15 minute walk from CEH) with prices from £80
- <u>The George Hotel</u> hotel in the centre of Wallingford (15 minute walk from CEH) with prices from £110 (not to be mixed up with The George Hotel in Dorchester on Thames!)
- Old School House bed and breakfast in Wallingford (20 minute walk from CEH) with prices from £95 per night including breakfast

#### Oxford

Oxford is a 30-40 minute bus journey from CEH on the X39 or X40 bus which run every 40 minutes throughout the day (every hour after 19:30), the last bus from Wallingford to Oxford runs at 22:45. A return bus ticket costs £5.60. The timetable is accessible <a href="here">here</a>.

- <u>Travelodge (Abingdon Road)</u> hotel on the Oxford ring road with prices from £64
- There are many other hotels/B&Bs/hostels in Oxford

## **Dorchester on Thames**

Dorchester on Thames is a small village around 4 miles from CEH and is a short walk to the A4074 to catch the X39/X40 service from Oxford (running every half an hour until 22:43 with a return ticket ~£5)

- <u>The George Hotel</u> hotel in Dorchester on Thames, rooms available from £69 per night including breakfast (not to be mixed up with The George Hotel in Wallingford!)
- Fleur De Lys Inn Small inn in Dorchester on Thames, rooms available from £70 per night including breakfast
